Glory Mold: 2084

We're looking for collaborators to work on our speculative sci-fi project Glory Mold, about a future world where humans live alongside a slime mold artificial intelligence. With Glory Mold we challenge the widespread adoption of AI in its current form, using immersion and play to explore how AI could develop differently.

Glory Mold: 2084 is an immersive installation that invites audiences to interact with the character of Glory Mold through touch, sound, movement, light and more. Glory Mold responds and plays like a slime mold - in deep connection with the environment, and in a multi-sensory, pluralistic and decentralised way. They tell stories about the future they have shaped, for better or worse. By interacting with Glory Mold we want audiences to sense, feel and experience an alternate reality.
